

Walking the Geo- and Pleasure Trail

The Geo- and Pleasure Trail "From Beer to Bratwurst" connects the Hotelpark Stadtbrauerei Arnstadt with the 1st German Bratwurst Museum in Holzhausen. Artistic sculptures by the artist Christoph Hodgson from Arnstadt are installed along the circular route to illustrate the close relationship between the natural setting and the regional culinary specialities. The 15 discovery stations provide you with information about the formation and fertility of the local soils, which is the foundation for the development of the culinary traditions and special products.

Records from Arnstadt Abbey document the first mention of the Bratwurst in 1404. Weizenbier (Wheat beer) is recorded in 1617, over 200 years later. The traditional Thuringian Bratwurst and the Wheat Beer of Arnstadt are deeply rooted in a landscape that is also one of the oldest cultivated landscapes in Thuringia. And for a good reason: the fertile soils, abundance of water and the mild climate enabled the early settlement of the region.

The Geo- and Pleasure Trail offers fascinating views in all directions, not just over the Thuringian Castle Country Drei Gleichen, but also of the peaks of the Thuringian Forrest, over Arnstadt and Erfurt. The rich and rare flora and fauna living alongside the trail further enhance the experience of walking this trail. Enjoy one of the most beautiful cultivated landscapes of Thuringia on the Geo- and Pleasure Trail.



Hotelpark Stadtbrauerei Arnstadt

Living tradition! The over 600 year old history of the Arnstadt Beer comes alive again on a historic brewery tour through the Hotelpark Stadtbrauerei Arnstadt. The 4-star hotel with 66 rooms is the cradle of the oldest Wheat beer in Germany. The hotel offers a modern interpretation of the Thuringian cuisine and boasts a Wellness area with a sauna landscape as well as a brine bath and a bowling centre. The Hotelpark Stadtbrauerei Arnstadt is starting point for the guided tours.



Ist German Bratwurst Museum Holzhausen

The Bratwurst is a way-of-life and cultural asset for many Thuringians and more. The 1st German Bratwurst Museum in Holzhausen near Arnstadt shows everything about the history, culture, production and tradition of the bratwurst all over the world. On display in the outdoor area are a giant grill, a show garden, a charcoal kiln, the bratwurst sculpture park, the bratwurst saurian as well as the largest walk-in bratwurst in the world. Special group tours and arrangements are available.


Attractions along the Geo- and Pleasure Trail

Enjoy the Geo- and Pleasure Trail "From Beer to Bratwurst" with all your senses. The circular route is designed to provide you with an insight into the environmental setting for the development of our cultural landscape and the regional culinary jewels. There are 15 discovery stations along the trail, each with a surprising sculpture or unique structure:

- Giant Beer at the Hotelpark Stadtbrauerei Arnstadt
- Giant Spoon, historic sandstone sculpture
- **Giant Hop Flower** in the former hop growing area
- **Giant Beet**
- **Walk-in Bratwurst** at the 1st German Bratwurst Museum in Holzhausen

- **Giant Crosier** at the old Abbey
- **Giant Vine**
- (B) Giant Herbs at the Eulenberg
- **Giant Fruit Basket** at the Eulenberg
- Giant Corn Ear at the Pfennigsberg
